## **Attendance Reminder**

The staff at Van Hise Elementary are continuing to prioritize our efforts for increasing student engagement. Attending school regularly helps children feel better about school - and themselves. Start building this habit in kindergarten so they learn right away that going to school on time and every day is important. Eventually good attendance will be a skill

that will help them succeed in high school and college. Partnership between VHE and our families:

- Set a regular bedtime and morning routine.
- Lay out clothes and pack backpacks the night before.
- Keep your child healthy, and make sure your child has the required shots.
- Develop backup plans for getting to school if something comes up. Call on a family member, a neighbor or another parent.
- Try to schedule non-Covid-19 related medical appointments and extended trips when school isn't in session.
- If your child seems anxious about going to school, talk to teachers, Ms. Stein, and other staff for advice on how to make your child feel comfortable and excited about learning. We are here for you!
- If you are concerned that your child may have Covid-19, call your school for advice. Nurse Lauri and Nurse Dawn can assist in questions and concerns.
- If your child must stay home due to illness or quarantine, ask the teacher for resources and ideas to continue learning at home.

We are working to make our school environment a place where everyone can be safe, healthy, and able to learn. We will do our best to listen and partner with you so that our children have a successful year. Do not hesitate to reach out to me with questions or concerns.


