Call to order

A meeting of the VHE PTO was called to order at 6:30 PM by Chrissy Greer.

Reports

Empowerment Groups + Committees

The first meeting for each of the parent empowerment groups has recently occurred. One remaining group to kickoff is this Thursday. These groups are open to all who are interested. Currently just small groups and trying to build on that.

Open Gym

Open gym & Day of Giving was this past weekend, November 9. 50 "Celebration Bags" were assembled to help stock the Community Room in the school.

The PTO has the gym scheduled once a month. These times can be for the entire school or be sponsored by one of the grade-levels.

Fall Grant Approval

Review of current grants from teachers and staff. If we approve all grants we will be over budget. Currently the PTO has \$5k budgeted per semester for these grants. Since the direct appeal has not kicked off yet, we do not know if we will be able to support these grants beyond the \$5k that has been budgeted. If we approve all of the Fall grants we may not be able to approve everything in the spring.

Recommendation was to approve the grants that we were not still waiting on answers from the district on - specifically those for new chairs as that may be able to come out of a different budget.

Need to find out if equipment needs to be bought through a specific vendor. Per Deb it does need to be purchased through an approved vendor - need to find out if those indicated are on the approved list.

Community Pulse Survey - Quarter 1 Review

- Quarterly seems too frequent consider twice a year instead
- Try to encourage people to not use specific names to avoid people feeling the lack of confidentiality
- PTO wants to continue to move forward using the pulse surveys to help inform the board.
